

Invitation to the French Delegation for the European Forum in Hambach, Germany

June 15 – June 18, 2007

EYP Germany would like to invite a French delegation consisting of no more than 15 students to the European Forum at the Castle of Hambach.

In 2007, the historical "Hambacher Fest" has its 175th anniversary. In May 1832 people from Germany, France and Poland came together at the castle of Hambach to protest against the ruling elite and fight for their rights to freedom and democracy.

For this anniversary, young people from all over Europe, especially from the federal state of Rheinland-Pfalz and its European partner regions, will come together at the Hambach (close to Koblenz) Castle.

The *European Forum Hambach* of the European Youth Parliament Germany will be held there, in order to exchange cultural ideas – to take part in political discussions and first and foremost to experience democracy on a European level.

Young people from Germany, France, Czech Republic, Slovakia and Poland are invited to share their thoughts on Europe's future.



The four days of the session are divided into three parts: Teambuilding, Committee Work and General Assembly. The first two parts will take place in suitable accommodation near *Neustadt an der Weinstraße*.

Thanks to the cooperation of the Hambach Castle Foundation, the General Assembly will take place at the historical Hambach Castle itself.
